# Overall Awards

Open Award Acquisitive: \$3,000

Best work from all sections. ALL entries will be judged for the Open Award prize. The winning entry will not be eligible to win in any other sections. The winning artwork of this award will be acquired by Hinchinbrook Shire Council.

Local Artist Award: \$800

Automatic entry for local artists (unless already a winner in any other section). Must have residential status within Hinchinbrook Shire and have done so for a period of 6 months at the exhibition date.

People's Choice Award: \$400

Viewers vote. Votes counted after closure of competition.

## Sections

1. Painting (2D): \$350

Any subject, any style in any medium.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

2. Watercolour: \$350

Traditional or contemporary watercolour on any support or base.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

3. Mixed Media: \$350

A combination of two or more different media.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

4. Drawing: \$350

Any drawing media on any support.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

5. Works on Paper: \$350

Any subject, any medium.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

6. Photography: \$350

Any subject, any style.

*\*Size Limit of 150cm x 120cm*

7. Ceramics: \$350

Any method of construction. Measurements of ceramic pieces not to exceed a maximum height of 1m with a base of not more than 0.75m x 0.5m to a maximum weight of 16 kilograms.

8. Sculptural Form: \$350

Any medium. Measurements of three dimensional pieces not to exceed a maximum height of 1m with a base of not more than 0.75m x 0.5m to a maximum weight of 16 kilograms.

9. Youth Award:

First Prize \$500, Runner Up: \$100

Young artists between 13 and 17.

Any subject, any medium.

*\*Size Limit 150cm x 120cm*

*\*Size Limit of all artworks unless otherwise stated: Size Limit 150cm x 120cm. This is inclusive of any framing. Size limits apply due to space constraints and the number of entries received. In an attempt to display all entries, please ensure your artwork adheres to these size limits.*



# Conditions of Entry

1. Unless otherwise specified, sections are open to all ages.
2. All works must be available for purchase (no exceptions).
3. All entries must be the **original work of the entrant and completed within the last 12 months.**
4. All works must be dry and suitable for handling.
5. Two-dimensional works must be suitably framed or fitted for hanging (a stretched canvas is considered framed). Entries must be ready for display with "D" rings securely attached (preferably 10cm from the top of the frame) (*Failure to comply will result in works being rejected*).
6. Three-dimensional works will be exhibited on a flat surface unless otherwise instructed. The competitor must supply alternative supports if required.
7. Each artist may submit a maximum of two entries per section. Each artwork can be entered in one section only. All artworks are eligible for the Open Prize and People's Choice Award, regardless of section entered.
8. The fee per entry is \$25 for all sections. All entry fees are non-refundable. Payment can be made via Eftpos, Cash or Cheque. Cheques are to be made out to Hinchinbrook Shire Council.
9. Entries must be submitted on the official Entry Form (or a copy) together with entry fees forwarded to reach the council or postmarked no later than 4.00pm Friday 06 July 2019. Late and unpaid entries will not be accepted.
10. All artworks must be delivered to TYTO Regional Art Gallery, 73-75 McIlwraith Street, Ingham from Saturday 6 July to Sunday 14 July 2019, 10.00am to 4.00pm. TYTO Regional Art Gallery is open 7 days allowing delivery of artworks midweek as well as on Saturday 6 and 13 July and Sunday 7 and 14 July 2019.
11. Entries received after such time will not be eligible for entry and the entrant will forfeit their entry fee. Please deliver your artwork without any packaging unless it is essential for safekeeping or required for return by courier.
12. Works may not be collected until after the exhibition closure. Works must be collected between 10.00am to 4.00pm from Tuesday 27 August to Sunday 1 September 2019 or by prior arrangement. Any entry not collected will be disposed of by the gallery.
13. Sold works cannot be released until after the closure of the exhibition.
14. All freight, insurance and transport costs in both directions are the responsibility of the entrant. Each competitor is responsible for maintaining his/her own insurance coverage.
15. The greatest possible care will be taken of all works, however works shall at all times remain at the risk of the entrant. Hinchinbrook Shire Council accepts no liability for loss or damage whatsoever to any work whilst in its custody or during transit.
15. All works sold will be subject to a commission of 20%.
16. Exhibited entries may be reproduced in print and electronic media, including, but not limited to, exhibition catalogues, entry forms and information sheets, for the purposes of publicity and promotion of the Hinchinbrook Art Awards and TYTO Regional Art Gallery, in perpetuity.
17. TYTO Regional Art Gallery reserves the right to exclude any works which do not meet the conditions or are deemed not in keeping with the standards of the exhibition. The gallery reserves the right not to hang all entries if space is limited. All entries will be viewed by the judge.
18. The TYTO Regional Art Gallery Coordinator and Manager of Economic and Community Development reserves the right to make the final decision in respect of any issue relating to the organisation and administration of the 2019 competition.
19. The winning artwork of the open award is acquisitive and will become a part of the Hinchinbrook Shire Council collection.
